The Provincial Exhibition.

The Provincial Exhibition for 1894 was brought to a close on Friday. In many respects it was the most successful ever held in our Province. The weather throughout was fine, which in itself was a great element of success. In our last issue we made some allusion to the exhibits within the building. The outside show, horses, cattle, sheep, pigs, etc., was not only very large, but for the most part excellent in character. There was a very large exhibit of the most beautiful animals, the horse, and very many of them of such symmetry, life and action that any Islander who loves a horse must have felt proud of a land that can produce such beautiful animals. The progress that has been made in our dairying interests, and in the manufacture of butter and cheese, is necessarily associated with improvements in the quality of the milk cow. And in this respect the exhibition was a good object lesson. The Jerseys, Guernseys and Holsteins shown were superior on the whole to those of former years. The exhibits of sheep, pigs, poultry, etc., were large and fine. The exhibits of agricultural implements were not, we imagine, as large as we have seen at former Provincial exhibitions.

The lotting, which is always a drawing card at our exhibitions, was very fine. Pilot J. is a beautiful animal and did some beautiful trotting. Parkside is also a splendid horse and speedy too, but he did not seem able to overtake his black rival. The other trotters were for the most part fine looking animals and gave a good account of themselves on the track. Elsewhere we give an account of the trotting. The crowd on Wednesday was not, perhaps, equal to that on some former similar occasions, but on Thursday there was a very large attendance. We give in this issue the total prize list. We cannot close this account of the Exhibition without placing on record our appreciation of the courtesies extended by the Secretary, A. B. Warburton, Esq., and his assistants.

According to British Columbia Conservative papers, while Mr. Laurier was credited in that Province by large audiences, and respectfully listened to, he went back without making any evident impression on the public mind. A man who does not know and cannot say, and who is afraid to learn the facts about the issues he raises, even when he has great oratorical powers, naturally fails to impress men whose business is affected by the political policy of the government of the day, and who want a public man's policy to be as definite and clear cut as a commercial proposition.—Montreal Gazette.

Mr. Miall, commissioner of inland revenue has returned from Winnipeg to Ottawa, where he has been to attend the western board of grain examiners. He says the Manitoba crop this year is the finest that has ever been grown in the Province. If the whole crop were mixed together it would grade No. 1 hard. Of No. 1 crop proper, Mr. Miall thinks that half of it would grade Extra No. 1 hard. White Chapman of Toronto, estimates that two thirds of the No. 1 crop would reach this high standard. Of 250 bags that were opened before the board, average weight was 62 pounds to the bushel, some running as high as 65 pounds. The average crop for the whole province will be 20 bushel to the acre. About one million acres were sown in wheat this year.

The Gloucester fishing schooner Carrie W. Babson, Captain Latham, arrived at North Sydney C. B. on Saturday from a baiting fishing voyage in Baffin Bay. The captain reports in three months had taken 100,000 lbs. There were six other vessels from Gloucester with him and they made an average catch of 100,000 lbs each being about the same as last year, but much better previous years. The weather was the best of the past two years interfered with the catch. The captain suggests that the government make a survey of the coast of Prince William's Sound or the west side of Baffin Bay. There is a very valuable fishing ground, but it is not generally known where salmon trout, a nice and very valuable fish are numerous. There is no chance of that coast and apparently no owner.

The Cathedral Bazaar.

The grand Cathedral Bazaar came to a close on Monday night, and it is most satisfactory to know that it has, in every way, been a great success. The gross receipts are well up to six thousand dollars, and the net proceeds will be considerably over five thousand. The weather, during the week of the Bazaar, was most charming—indeed all that could be desired. On each night the rink was well thronged with visitors; but on Wednesday and Thursday nights it was literally packed. On each of these days—taking the day and evening together—three thousand people must have visited the Bazaar. The dinner and tea tables provided drawing cards, the excellence of the meal furnished and the low price charged had the effect of attracting an extensive patronage. The oyster, ice-cream and other refreshments were most liberally patronized, and at these booths a most thriving business was done each evening. The fancy tables did such a thriving business that after Friday night little remained on them to be disposed of. The flower stand was not only an attractive feature of the Bazaar, but was also one of the most profitable, while the literary table was an unprecedented success.

The solicitors for the different lotteries pushed their canvass most vigorously, the funds of the Bazaar being largely enhanced as a result. Every night there was a band concert, as well as choice piano music, while the pleasurable ministered to the pleasure of the visitors by throwing on the canvas the choicest stereopticon views. The risk was transformed into a great live of industry, where the numerous workers, as busy as bees, night after night plied their different avocations with a laudable emulation and with unflagging energy. The best of good feeling prevailed and all seemed to have but one object in view—the success of the Bazaar.

Some of the lotteries were drawn on Saturday night and the others on Monday night. The auction sales also commenced on Saturday night and were concluded on Monday night. The auctioneers were A. McNeill and R. Beattie, Esqs. Such of the great oaks as were not lotteried were sold at auction. It was found impossible to wind up the whole business on Saturday night as at first anticipated, so the conclusion of the auction sales and the lotteries of the principal articles were postponed till Monday night when the work was completed. The most valuable articles lotteried on Monday night were the buggy donated by Large & Son, the piano lamp donated by Mr. Howland, and the gold watch donated by Rev. F. J. McDonald. The success of the Bazaar is a fair example of what can be accomplished by unanimity of purpose, by all working together and contributing according to their means. When any laudable work is entered upon with these dispositions it cannot fail of success.

The parlor lamp donated by Mrs. Howland, was won by D. O. M. Reddin. The silver service given by Benjamin Rogers, Esq. M. I. A. was won by Mrs. J. B. McDonald, the painting presented by Robert Harris, R. C. A. was won by Mrs. W. W. Sullivan; the gold watch presented by Rev. F. J. McDonald fell to the lot of Robert Horne, and the buggy presented by Large & Son fell to W. L. Hornsby; Mrs. James Byrne won the silver cake basket.

The beans in the bottle, by means of which the winner of Professor Miller's scholarship was to be decided, were counted on Monday night and were found to number 23,126. The winner of the scholarship was Rev. A. J. McIntyre of Point, his guess being 23,055, the nearest to the actual number.

The piece of sword, of a sword-fish, to which we referred last week as being found stuck in the hull of the steamer Elliott, was loaned to the Bazaar by Captain McMillan. It was a curiosity that was gazed by a large number of persons while on exhibition.

The contest for the most popular society, between the Benevolent Irish Society and the Ancient Order of Hibernians, commenced on Friday night and closed on Saturday night. It was won by the A. O. H. of the standing: A. O. H. 847, B. I. S. 847.

The election for the most popular Leader in Dominion politics, between Sir John Thompson and Hon. Wilfred Laurier, closed on Wednesday night, and resulted in favor of Laurier, the vote standing: Laurier 628, Sir John Thompson 455.

The free policy of insurance for one year, give by Mr. T. B. Mothersill, fell to the lot of His Lordship Bishop McDonald.
