C. TRADE WITH CANADA

The U.K. is Canada's most important trading partner in Europe. Total two-way trade in 1981 was worth \$5,555 million. It is our fourth most important export market and our sixth most important source of imports.

- Canada has consistently enjoyed a trade surplus with the U.K. In 1981, exports increased by 4.2% while imports grew by 13.1%.
