Increased trade aim of air agreements

Increased trade and tourism between Canada and Portugal is one major result expected from an air transport agreement signed by representatives of the two countries last month in Toronto.

The new air transport agreement, signed April 10 in the city that is home to Canada's largest Portuguese community, is the result of negotiations carried out in Sept. 1986 and replaces an agreement that has been in effect since 1947, say air transport officials.

The deal enables Canadian Airlines International Ltd. (CAIL), formerly Canadian Pacific Airlines Ltd., to provide scheduled access to one more Portuguese point in addition to Lisbon, which the carrier now serves.

Winners of the 1987 Canada Export Award will be presented by Minister Carney on October 5 at Ottawa's Chateau Laurier Hotel during a luncheon ceremony organized by the Department of External Affairs in conjunction with the annual meeting of the Canadian Exporters' Association.

Another air agreement, also aimed at increasing trade and particularly, tourism this time between Canada and the Arab Republic of Egypt — was announced last month by External Affairs Minister Joe Clark and Minister of Transport, John Crosbie.
