4. The Requested State shall promptly inform the Requesting State of the reasons for refusing or postponing the execution of a request.

#### ARTICLE 3

## Central Authorities

- A Central Authority shall be established by each Contracting State.
- For Canada, the Central Authority shall be the Minister of Justice or an official designated by the Minister of Justice.
- 3. For the Kingdom of Thailand, the Central Authority shall be the Attorney General or an official designated by the Attorney General.
- 4. Requests under this Treaty shall be made by the Central Authority of the Requesting State to the Central Authority of the Requested State.

### ARTICLE 4

#### Language

Requests and supporting documents shall be accompanied by a translation into an official language of the Requested State.

## ARTICLE 5

# Contents of Requests for Mutual Assistance

- A request for assistance shall be submitted in writing. In urgent circumstances or where otherwise permitted by the Requested State, a request may be made by facsimile but shall be confirmed in writing promptly thereafter.
- All requests shall include the following:
  - (a) the name of the competent authority conducting the investigation, prosecution or
