10.20 a.m. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh arrive at Exhibition Park.

The Mayor of Nanaimo presents the Mayors and Chairmen of Councils of adjacent cities and villages, Indian Chiefs, officials of the Native Brotherhood and their wives.

Her Majesty is asked to accept a bouquet.

The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh see exhibitions of Indian dancing and Indian handicraft following which Mayor and Mrs. Maffeo say good-bye.

10.45 a.m. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh re-enter their automobile and leave Exhibition Park for Chemainus Sawmill.
