- Canada is a leader in ensuring that gender concerns are incorporated into APEC's work. In 2001, Canada produced Gender Mainstreaming: Good Practices from the Asia-Pacific Region, and in 2002 conducted a Review of Gender Integration in APEC, which documented and reflected on the cumulative change in APEC mecanisms in integrating gender concerns over the four-year period between ministerial meetings.
- Canada and the All-China Youth Federation organized an APEC Young Entrepreneurs' Forum in 2001 which brought together more than 200 young business leaders to discuss issues of the New Economy.
- In 2002, Canada hosted a meeting of ABAC in Vancouver, bringing senior business executives from all across the APEC region to Canada.
