Mr. Blanchette, Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of National Defence, laid before the House,—Statement with respect to Pensions and Gratuities for the year ended March 31, 1953, Section 65, Defence Services Pension Act, Chapter 63, R.S.C., 1952.

And also,—Statement of Replacement of Materiel for the year ended March 31, 1953, Section 11 (4), National Defence Act, Chapter 184, R.S.C., 1952.

The House resumed the adjourned Debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Hollingworth for an Address to His Excellency the Governor General in Reply to His Speech at the Opening of the Session, and on the proposed motion of Mr. Drew in amendment thereto, and on the proposed motion of Mr. Coldwell, in amendment to the said proposed amendment.

And the Debate continuing; the said Debate was, on motion of Mr. Gauthier (Portneuf), adjourned.
