The Order of the Day being called for resuming the adjourned Debate on the motion of the Honourable Mr. Sproule, seconded by the Honourable Mr. Beaubien, that an humble Address be presented to His Royal Highness the Governor General to offer the humble thanks of this House for the gracious Speech which he has been pleased to address to both Houses of Parliament (Vide p. 19)—

During the Debate,

Two Senators having arisen together to speak,

The Honourable the Speaker left the decision of precedence to the Senate.

The Honourable Mr. Bolduc moved, seconded by the Honourable Mr. Taylor,

That the Honourable Member for De Lanaudière be now heard.

Which was resolved in the affirmative.

It being six o'clock, the Honourable the Speaker left the Chair, to resume the same at half past seven o'clock.

7.30 P.M.

The Senate resumed.

After further Debate,

The question of concurrence being put on the said motion, it was unanimously resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That the said Address be presented to His Royal Highness the Governor General by such Members of the Senate as are Members of the Privy Council.

The Senate adjourned.
