CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE VI.--Duties of Officers.

The President, and in his abscence the Vice-President, shall preside at all meetings of the Club; but in the absence of both President and Vice-President, a meeting of the Club shall elect its presiding officer. The Secretary-Treasurer shall keep the records of the Club, attend to all Club correspondence, keep the accounts of the Club and report thereon to the Committee of Management when required to do so. He shall also submit his accounts to the annual meeting.

ARTICLE VII. — Deputy Secretary-Treasurer.

The Secretary-Treasurer, by written authority to be posted on the board, may designate any ordinary member to act as his deputy in his absence for all purposes except the receipt and payment of money.

ARTICLE VIII. - Managing Committee.

The general concerns of the Club shall be managed by a committee of nine members, which committee shall consist of the President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer, and six other members to be elected by ballot at each annual meeting.

ARTICLE IX. - Duties of Managing Committee.

The managing committee shall have power to fill vacancies in their own body; shall take cognizance of all infractions of the Club constitution and rules; shall have authority to deal with all matters relating to good order and the conduct of members, and may recommend to a special meeting the suspension or expulsion of any member for improper conduct; and may make from time to time such regulations consistent with these general rules as they shall think necessary for the management and well-being of the Club. It shall also be the
