by some of the larger Missions and Stations in the Diocese. To this sum the Church Society, by way of encouragement have added Four hundred Dollars.

The Quebec Chapel Endowment originally set on foot by J. B. Forsyth Esq., has been formed by the liberal donations of a few warm friends of the Church residing in Quebec and elsewhere, a list of whom is attached to this Report.

Your Committee take the liberty of stating that Two other Endowment Funds exist.—The Nicolet Endowment under the management of the Central Board and the Quebec Rectory Endowment, under the management of the Churchwardens of the Cathedral Congregation.

In conclusion, your Committee would earnestly draw the attention of those who wish to become Benefactors in the Church to the necessity of forming Endowment funds for all the Missions in the Diocese, so that the Clergy shall not be left to depend altogether on voluntary contributions, which at best are precarious and capricious. An opportunity is now offered to those who may be disposed to give a portion of the Talents committed to their charge: it will be as seed cast into good ground bringing forth a hundred fold.

Your Committee hope that at the end of another year, they will be able to report that other Endowments have been formed and that those now formed have been largely increased.
