TANK STEAMER SEIZED.

NEW YORK, Aug. 13.—The taking of the German tank steamer *Leda*, a prize probably worth a quarter of a million dollars, by a prize crew from the British steamer *Suffolk*, and the arrest of upwards of 100 German reservists in Bermuda as prisoners of war, were confirmed by Captain R. L. Duple of the Royal Mail steam packet *Caribbean*, which arrived this noon from Bermuda. Similar confirmations were brought by the Bermudian of the Quebec Steamship Company.
