Amendment

4. For the purpose of this Act, the harbor of Belleville comprises so much of the waters of the Bay of Quinte as is included in the following boundaries:

Commencing at a point where the boundary between the townships of Sidney and Thurston intersects the ordinary high water line of the Bay of Quinte, thence easterly along the Bay of Quinte and the Morris River following the high water line to a point at the most southerly extremity of Ox Point, thence on a straight line across the Bay of Quinte to a point on the high water line at the most northerly extremity of Massawog Point in the township of Ardenburg, thence easterly along the high water line of the township of Ardenburg to a point where the boundary between the townships of Sidney and Thurston extends across the Bay of Quinte, thence the said high water line thence northerly along the extended boundary between the townships of Sidney and Thurston to the point of beginning and all water front property, water lots, piers, docks, wharves and beaches in or along the said waters; the location of Ox Point and Massawog Point are those shown on Canadian Hydrographic Chart No. 2600.

5. The Corporation may erect marks or signs to indicate the points of the harbor and such marks or signs shall be held to determine, govern, pass, the said limits.

6. (1) The Corporation shall consist of three commissioners one of whom shall be the Mayor for the time being of the city of Belleville and two of whom shall be appointed by the Governor in Council.

(2) Each commissioner appointed by the Governor in Council shall, without removal, hold office for three years, and is eligible for reappointment.

7. A commissioner appointed by the Governor in Council may resign his office by sending written notice of his resignation to the Governor in Council.

Before any commissioner enters upon the execution of his duties as commissioner, he shall take and subscribe an oath that he will truly and impartially and to the best of his skill and understanding execute the powers vested in him as a member of the Corporation and such oaths shall be filed on record in the office of the Corporation.
