

## THE POLAND-CHINA HOG.



There has always been a great deal of controversy in regard to the origin of this very valuable breed of hogs. Ohio is admitted to be the state where this hog originated and was developed for several years. They should have short legs, deep sides, straight broad back, full square hams and shoulders; short head, wide between the eyes; drooping ears; color black, with more or less white markings. They are vigorous, hardy, prolific and good sucklers.

## THE CHESTER WHITE HOG



**E**VERY breeder of white hogs is familiar with the Chester White which came originally from Chester County, Pa. They are good sized and very easy fatteners. The hair is white and thin; body long and deep; legs short and strong; head and neck short; thin ears, lopping at the point.

## TAMWORTH HOGS.



**N**EVER in the history of the hog has a breed made more rapid strides than this British breed. In color they are a bright sandy red. The breed is now famous for early maturity, while the long deep sides, light shoulder, and jowl are just what the pork packer requires. The flesh is lean, pink and delicious in flavor, the percentage of lean meat being very high.
