

A By-Law,

*To Transfer the authority vested in this Council over Roads
Township Municipalities*

WHEREAS by a certain By-Law of this County Council March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and provided that the several Township Municipalities, "pro should assume the responsibility of making, maintaining of County Roads bordering on such Municipalities. And in the Municipal Act render it necessary that all doubt and extent of the authority vested by this Council in them by a more explicit delegation of the powers possessed by to the minor Municipalities.

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Warden and Municipal Council of Norfolk in Municipal Council assembled, that from and all authority now vested in, or possessed by, this Council within the limits of the several Townships in this County by vested in the respective Township Councils within to be performed; to be by the said several Township Councils full and perfect a manner as could or might be done by this By-Law had not been passed; anything in the Act or other to the contrary notwithstanding.
