SIR AND BROTHER,

The Annual Meeting of the Provincial Grand Orange Lodge of Western Canada, will be held in the Town of Brampton, on Tuesday, the 18th day of February, at the hour of 12 o'Clock noon.

Where the Master of any Primary Lodge cannot attend, it is the duty of the Lodge to appoint a Proxy, so that *every* Lodge in the Province may be represented.

The Great Western Railway Company will carry Delegates at a fare and a quarter, and the Grand Trunk and Northern at one fare. Delegates will be furnished at Brampton with certificates, signed by the Grand Master, certifying that they have attended the Grand Lodge Meeting, said certificate to be presented to Railway Ticket Agent.

N.B.—The Grand Secretary would again impress upon Masters of Primary, District, and County Lodges, the great importance of making their Returns to this Office immediately after their Annual Elections; and also to see that all Grand Lodge and Delegate Dues are paid up by the Primary Lodges under their jurisdiction, before the Books are submitted to the Grand Auditors.

The G. S. has furnished to the County Master detailed statements of the Grand Lodge Dues paid and unpaid by each Lodge in his County since 1859.

All sentences of suspension and expulsion from the Order, must be taken from the Primary Lodge to the District, thence to the County for confirmation, and be entered on the several Returns, otherwise they will not be entertained by the Grand Lodge.
