T The Second and Third Collects at Evening Prayer.

T Then the People shall say after the Minister.—Turn Thou us, &c.
T Read the usual Prayers to the End of that, “For the Clergy and People.”

Then the Prayer in Time of War and Tumults.

O Almighty God, King of all Kings, and Governor of all things, whose power no creature is able to resist, to whom it belongeth justly to punish sinners, and to be merciful to them that truly repent: Save and deliver us, we humbly beseech Thee, from the hands of our enemies; abate their pride; assuage their malice, and confound their devices, that we, being armed with Thy defence, may be preserved evermore from all perils, to glorify Thee, who art the only giver of all victory, through the merits of Thy only Son Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Then the prayer for the Army and Navy—O God, the King of Glory, in whose Hands are all dominion, &c.

A Prayer for the Safety of our Fleets—O Eternal Lord God, whose Voice, &c.

A Prayer for this Church and Kingdom—O Lord, who makest all men to be of one mind, &c.

A Prayer for our Enemies—O Lord, and Heavenly Father, who wouldest not that any should perish, &c.

T Then the Prayer for the King's Recovery—O God who commandest us, &c.

T A Prayer for the Prince Regent—Protect us we beseech &c.

T Then the Prayer for all Conditions of Men.

The Prayer against relapsing—We humbly beseech Thee, most merciful God, that by thy Grace, &c. and so to the end of Evening Prayer.
