

For these services hard work must be done to secure a large attendance of the boys who are connected with the parish, and of boys who are not. Naturally every member of the Chapter will invite as many boys as he possibly can to attend the service. Card notices may be distributed at the houses and schools of the neighborhood, or wherever else they can be brought to the attention of the boys. Each member of the Chapter may be provided with a few of the cards and asked to hand them or mail them to his friends. A good way to secure the names of a large number of boys to invite to the service is to ask each member of the Chapter to write out a list of the names and addresses of all the boys he knows who are not likely to come to the service unless they receive a special invitation. Compare these lists, cross out duplicates, assign to each member of the Chapter a few of the names on the revised lists with the understanding that he will try to secure the presence of those whose names have been given him.

The offering may be devoted to some charitable or missionary work with which the boys of the neighborhood are or can be made acquainted.
