Continued From Page 1. necessary to cover up the ruthless disposal of natural resources. The curse of the party system had been exemplified in the United States where the forests had become annihilated.

The government had paid the opposition compliment in adopting their suggestion of placing the mines on a royalty basis, but they had not gone far enough.

Source of Revenue. The great revenues of the present government boasted were flowing in as a result of laws made by the old government.
