time for discussing the bill, but he was doubtful whether the County Council should be given power to quash municipal by-laws; while the extension of the jurisdiction of County Courts in relation to lites, mortgages and other cases of that kind mentioned might have the opposite effect intended by increasing litigation.

Dr. Bar's bill to amend the Municipal Act in relation to clerical errors at elections was given a second reading; also Mr. Little's, to provide machinery to enable municipalities to return to the ward system; Mr. Dickenson's, to enable municipalities to make grants to cemeteries, and several bills in relation to assessment matters.

Hon. J. H. Stratton stated that when W. F. R. Preston left the services of the province he promised to liquidate his indebtedness to the province as soon as he conveniently could. [Laughter.] He has since paid the full amount. George Wheeler, now in the employment of the Government at a salary of \$1100 a year, has promised to pay off a smaller indebtedness at a rate of not less than \$75 a year. He owes the province \$900.

Mr. Dryden will introduce a Government bill next week to improve the Act respecting shops and places other than factories. The correspondence between the Ontario Government and the Imperial authorities respecting a remount station, which was published in the Legislature yesterday afternoon. The reply thru Lord Strathcona was that the War Office did not regard the proposal favorably.

THE DODGE WORKED NICELY.

Quebec Detectives Recovered All Except \$12 Out of \$1000 Stolen From a Bank.

Montreal, March 15.—(Special.)—The Quebec detectives, Fleury and Walsh, are now stated over a clever plan which they invented to recover \$1000, which had been stolen from the Quebec branch of the Provincial Bank. The officers of the law strongly suspected a certain individual of the theft, yet they had doubts as to whether they should make the arrest. They, however, sent the suspected party a letter written in a lady's handwriting, which had been addressed to her, and in which she had been told to return the money to the Joint Bankers at St. Saviour. This trick worked like a charm, for in a few hours the thief presented himself at the bank's office, and getting into the hands of the police, he promised to return the money to the bank manager.
