Crown Reserve was heavy through the day, and fraders are expecting this stock to sell domsiderably lower. The manouncement of a resegnization of the Silver Bar Company brought albout a substantial department of the sate of the stand for this stock. La Rose was steadily bought all day, and many orders are still in hand, but that most of these show good discretion.
