Recapitulation of Shipments of Wood Goods From St. John, N. B., to United Kingdom, Continent, Canada Has Decid-Australia, etc.

There were 386 tons of birch timber shipped in November, compared with 260 tons in November, 1903. The total shipments of birch timber this year to Nov. 30 were 2811 tons, compared with 3695 for the like period last year. Of pine timber two tons were shipped this year and three in the eleven months of last year.
