Moved in amendment to the amendment, by Rev. B. Shaw, and seconded,

That any substitute who takes the place of any principal delegate elected to this Synod shall continue as if he were the principal delegate during the session of the Synod; but this shall not prevent any principal delegate from being elected as a member of any Standing Committee, or any delegation, if the Synod should think fit so to elect.

Hon. E. Willis, seconded by Mr. C. N. Vroom, moved the previous question, which was passed in the affirmative.

The Chair put the question on Mr. Chandler's original motion, which was Carried.

Mr. R. T. Clinch made a verbal report that he had examined the Contingent Fund Accounts, and found them correct.
