### Queen Alexandra's Simple Diet

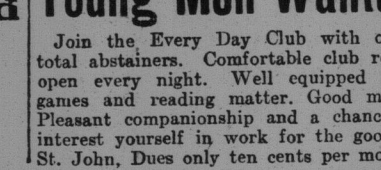
The secret of Queen Alexandra's won-
