NOTICE TO HOLDERS OF
TIMBER LICENSES
Chatham, N. B., 24th July, 1897.
The attention of all holders of Timber Licenses is
called to Section 19 of the Timber Regulations
which reads as follows:—
"19. No license holder shall cut or
remove any timber, or allow any
other person to do so, without
obtaining a license from the
Commissioner of Lands and
Forestry, and such license shall
be in accordance with the
regulations made by the
Commissioner in this behalf, and
the holder of such license shall
be liable to a fine of not less
than \$100 and not more than
\$500, and to imprisonment for
not less than 30 days and not
more than 6 months, and to
forfeiture of his license, and to
the costs of such proceedings,
if he fails to comply with the
regulations made by the
Commissioner in this behalf."
