THE FARM.

The Selection of Seeds. Carefully conducted experiments do not always justify long-established and sottled opinions. Here is a case in point, which we find in the *Weekly World*:

Doite, which we find in the Weekly World: The idea prevails to a considerable ex-tent that great. improvements may be made in the productiveness of agricul-tural plants by the careful selection of the largest and plumpest seeds for planturg. With a view of learning to what extent, if any, such improvements could be brought about, an experimental trial was made at the station of the Maine State College of Agriculture last seeson, as follows : Four varieties of oats were taken, from which were selected the largest, heavies kernels, to the amount of two quarts in each case. These were sown on plots of land welve feet by ninety feet, while like amounts of the same varieties of oats, which were taken from the common stock, were sown on plots received the same treatment as to plots received the same treatment as to ultivation and manure.
