However, we are advised now that nothing further can be done until after the holidays, and from experience we would conclude possible drilling will not commence before March or April at least.

We regret, after the adcomedation the Department has shown us by extending payment on rentals, to be obliged to ask for another six months; extension in which to get development under way and lease rentals fully satisfied.

Obstacles have made it extremely difficult for us, but we have kept unceasingly at it, and with every assurance, now, of witimate success.

Will you kindly place this request before the Department and accept our gratitude for your co-operation in getting development under way. To-operation must be, in order to place this field in the forefront.
