

New York, Dec. 30.—Six enterprises controlled by the Siegel Stores Corporation, in this city and in Boston, were thrown into bankruptey today in a friendly proceedings instituted in the federal courts. The concerns did an annual gross business estimated at forty million dollars, but it is understood that their Christmas business did not come up to expectations and they found themselves hard pressed by curtailment of banking credit. The fallure had been discounted in the financial district and had no effect on the stock market.
