Professor Soret, in delivering a most interesting report, passed in review the operations of the Industrial section, in reference to Commerce, laying great stress upon the competition that has taken place in the manufacture of chronometers. This competition was instituted with the object of testing the workmanship and precision of chronometers turned out by Genevase manufacturers, and none but those adopted for poaket use were admitted. They were deposited in charge of the authorities at the Observatory, and underwent the most searching ordeal nossible to be applied to pocket instruments of this class. The jury specially retained to decide the difficult question as to whom to award the palm of excellency unanimously decided in favor of Messrs. J. M. Badollet & Co.
