By the Honorable Mr. *Flint*; of *H. D. Smith, M. P. P.*, and others, of the Village of *Merrickville, County of Grenville, Ontario*.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the following Petitions were severally read :—

Of *N. Rosa* and others, of the City of *Quebec*, praying for the passing of an Act to amend the Act 23rd *Victoria*, chapter 123, to incorporate the Pilots for and below the Harbor of *Quebec*; and of *John McDonald* and others, of the Town of *Ingersoll*, in the County of *Oxford*; praying for the passing of a Patent Law similar to the Law of *England*, or for the passing of a Law granting Patents to the Inventors alone, irrespective of nationality or residence.

The Honorable Mr. *Hamilton (Kingston)*, from the Committee on Banking, Commerce and Railways, to whom was referred the Bill intituled: "An Act to amend the Act of Incorporation of the Board of Trade of the City of *Toronto*," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the House without any amendment.
