BILL.

An Act to repeal the Statute 16 Victoria, chapter 80, and to make better provision for preventing infractions of the Laws against Usury.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Act hereinafter mentioned, and Preamble. to make better provision for preventing infractions of the Laws against Usury; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The Act passed in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and Act. 16 V. c. 5 intituled, "An Act to modify the Usury Laws," shall be and is hereby 80 repealed. repealed.

II. If any person lending money to another shall require him to pur- Penalty for chase or take, privately or openly, any property, article or thing whatever, making a borthe value or price whereof is to be considered as part of the sum lent, or anything and 10 deducted therefrom by the lender, or if such lender shall in any way reckoning the whatever induce the borrower to take a less sum than that mentioned in price as part the bond, obligation, note or security given by the borrower in considera- lent. tion of such loan, then such lender shall only be entitled to recover the sum really lent with interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum, and shall 15 also forfeit to the borrower a sum equal to one-fifth part of the sum for which such bond, obligation, note or security shall have been given, and if he shall have received more than is allowed by this Act, the borrower may recover it back from him; and such forfeiture and such sum as last aforesaid, may be recovered as a debt due by such lender to such borrower.

III. So much of any law relating to Usury as may be inconsistent with Inconsistent this Act, is hereby repealed.
