HillAnd besit enacted. That it shall be law- 15 ful for any of the said Trustees, or their successors, blockresign the trust-held: by himein virtue of the said Act, or of this Act at any time, or times hereafter by letter addressed to any other job the Trustees for the time 20 being.

Trustees may till up any vacancy in their number b y election.

III. And be it enacted.
