*Upper Canada*—Used in Deeds, &c., after Union, will not vitiate them, 138.

*Use of English and French Languages* in Houses of Parliament and Quebec, 133.—*See French Language.*

*Vacancies*—In Legislative Council, Quebec, filled by Lieutenant Governor, 75.

—In Office of Speaker, Ontario and Quebec, filled as directed for Commons in 45th Section, 87.

—Of seats of Senators by resignation, 30. In other cases, 31. Filled by Governor General, 32. Or by Her Majesty, 26. (*See Rule 10.*)

*Voting in Senate*, 36; in Commons, 49; in Legislative Council, Quebec, 79. In Assemblies, Ontario and Quebec, 79, 49.

*Weights and Measures*—Under exclusive control of General Government, 91 (17).

*Witnesses at the Bar of the Senate and before Committees.*—*See Oaths.*

*Works, Public*—*See Public Works.*

*Works, Local, and Undertakings* in Provinces—Under their exclusive control, *except* lines of Steam or other Ships, Railways, Canals, Telegraphs, and other works connecting a Province with any other of the Provinces, or extending beyond the limits of a Province, or situate within a Province, but declared by Parliament to be of public utility, 92 (10a).
