CAP. XXXVII.

An Act to establish a Court having jurisdiction
in Appeals and Criminal Matters, for Lower-
Canada.

[30th May, 1849.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter and reform Preamble.
the judicial system of Lower-Canada, which
hath been found in some respects inadequate to the
due administration of justice in that division of the
Province, and for that purpose, among other things,
to establish therein a Court having jurisdiction in
Appeals and Criminal Matters: Be it therefore
enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Pro-
vince of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue
of and under the authority of an Act passed in the
Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain
and Ireland, and intituled, *An Act to re-unite the
Provinces of Upper and Lower-Canada, and for the
Government of Canada*, and it is hereby enacted by
the authority of the same, That the Act passed in the
seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled,
*An Act for the establishment of a better Court of
Appeals in Lower-Canada*, shall be and is hereby Act 7 Vict. c.
18, repealed.
repealed; but all Acts and provisions of law thereby Proviso.
repealed shall nevertheless remain repealed.
