Your letter of Feb 17th to hand.
I regret not replying to yours of Jan
8th before now, however up to the
present time I find I am unable to
remit even a small amount to apply
on the above land. I have however
prospects of some revenue within the
next month or six weeks, and if at all
possible I will forward something on
account to your department.

The crop for 1935, while being
1620 bushels, only met expenses and the
full amount was paid out on the farm
with no resulting profit to myself.

This together with expenses involved in
my moving to B.C. has left me
decidedly short of cash.

I am hoping for better results in
1936, otherwise I will of necessity have
to give up the land.
