portent and measure of our future relationships,
that we shall carry on together, in the spirit of
these war years. It is required not merely for our
own sakes but for the sake of a world which has
lea med what cooperation in war can accomplish, and
which must now understand the cooperation that we must
achieve to make peace secure.
