LONDON Prime Minister Churchill admitted that the German long range V2 rocket have been hitting England for some weeks. He said they contained about the same amount of explosive as the V-1 rocket. They fly to a height of 60 miles and penetrate more deeply on striking. Damage has been scattered and there is no cause for alarm.

N.W. FRONT The last resistance on WALCHEREN Island has ceased. It was announced that the Queen's Own Rifles and the Essex Scottish were among the Canadian units taking part in the SCHUDELDE battles. The American Third Army is making progress with seven divisions near METZ and is likely to outflank the city soon. The Allied troops are at the town of BURG twenty two miles NORTH EAST of METZ, while the southern flank reaches thirty three miles to the SOUTH EAST to MONCOURT.

ITALY British Eighth Army troops have captured the town of FORLI.

HUNGARY The Russian Forces are advancing on a 40 mile front NORTH EAST of UDAPEST and have gained 15 miles and captured 50 places. MOSCOW stated that in the Hungarian offensive the Russians had killed 100,000 Axis troops and captured 42,000.

Tito's partisans killed 1,000 Germans near PRIVOLAK in southern SERBIA. The Germans have moved reinforcements into DANILOVGRAD in MONTENEGRO.

CHINA The Japanese claim to have captured LIUCHOW in SOUTH EAST CHINA.

PHILIPPINES The Japanese have rushed 35,000 reinforcements to fight the Americans on LUYTE Island.

AIR A force of 1300 bombers dropped four thousand tons of bombs in support of the METZ offensive.
