Plea in mitigation

I'd like to bring to the court's attention a few details as respect to the accused's army record. So the accused was born 26 May 1925. He first enlisted 8 Sept. 1941 Discharged 20 July 1942 as he was underage through Category "A". He attempted to reenlist 15 Feb. 1943; he was turned down as medically unfit. He was called up 8 Jan 1944, he was ~~Put~~ Category "A". He voluntarily went active immediately. He came overseas to England 6 July 44, went to France on the 18 of that same month and the following day went as reinforcement to the H.L.I. of C. He has served approximately 105 days in the front line then reporting to the unit M.O. for stomach trouble. He was evacuated and a more thorough examination at the hospital proved his complaint.

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
