This statement is true.

2. Then questioned concerning the blank pass which bore the unit orderly room stamp, McCloy stated that these were easily obtained as they were often kept in a small room in the billets where the passes were handed out to personnel going on leave. A close check of his person and property failed to locate any more of these blank passes, so it is presumed that he only took the one mentioned in his statement, which he subsequently destroyed.

3. It will be noted in previous report deted 29 Mar 43, submitted by Sgt. MOLNE of this branch (pers 2), that empirical instigated by him established the fact that this soldier is in presentation of funds from a family source which emables him to finance himself during his periods of shance without resorting to crime. There is no evidence available at this office which would suggest that McCley has been implicated in anything of a criminal nature.
