

- Q. Did you ever check Brisson's truck, the number of Brisson's truck?
A. No sir.
- Q. I am going to show you a sketch of a certain area and I want you to tell the Court whether you recognize this area?
(Shows a sketch to the witness)
- A. I cannot identify the place correctly - even on the road itself I couldn't identify the place.
- Q. Before you left on your journey that Sunday after you had been warned for that job what did you do with Brisson? Did you immediately move on the job or did you hang around somewhere? Before receiving orders to leave that Sunday did you immediately proceed on the job or hang around somewhere?
A. Pte Brisson was on duty before me and he had to go to the sea and get some ammunition.
- Q. But before this journey where Brisson fired some rounds - before they started on their journey after being ordered to do so did they immediately move to it or did they hang around somewhere?
A. After having received the order for that trip we went to the garage.
- Q. And what did you do there?
A. When we got to the garage Pte Brisson managed somewhere to have liquor, I don't know how. I had a glass of it myself and he had a few, I couldn't say how many.
- Q. Did you drink the same liquor as Brisson drank?
A. Yes sir.
- Q. How many drinks did you say you had?
A. At the garage one glass.
- Q. Did you had any of that stuff before on that day?
A. I had two or three glasses of it previously.
- Q. How long previously?
A. Four or five hours before.
- Q. At the scene of the incident how were you feeling, were you - had you all your senses of yourself?
A. I felt - I wasn't quite myself and that is why I stopped, I was worried over the truck.
- Q. I will show you here a Sten, a weapon, and I would like to know if you can recognize it before, marked Exhibit "L"?
A. I cannot recognize that weapon, I couldn't say this is the one he had.
- Q. How far was it where this thing happened from the garage?
A. From one mile to one mile and one quarter.
- Q. When you saw Brisson the first time how was he walking - I mean not for the first time I mean after the MPs came back with him?
A. He was staggering.
- Q. Was he held by the MPs?
A. They were holding him.
