Dear Bob:

I have for answer your letter of December 12. An Indian does not have to pay Income Tax upon earnings made on his home reserve. Therefore the Six Nations Indians do not pay Income Tax on their earnings as teachers in our schools.

I hope Mr. Frederickson will agree to the survey at Saanich and I will expect to hear from you in the near future. I was pleased to note your reaction to the work being done at Lebret - but I note you were not impressed with the Boys' School at Spanish. I believe that since I last visited the school, he has lost many of his original staff.
