Typinpshien Council of Hartley Bay, B.C.

Te Preserve Peace and Order and to promote the General Welfare of the Community, the Natives of the Kitkahta Band residing at Hartley Bay, do hereby establish an Association to be known as The Tysimpshian Council of Hartley Bay.

BYLAWS OF SAID COUNCIL

I. The Council shall consist of nine members of the Band who are all above the age of twenty-one years.

2. The election of such Council shall be by ballot and shall take place every three years in the first week of January. One half of the members qualified to vote, shall form a quorem and a majority of the members present shall be sufficient to elect. The Councillors thus elected, shall hold office until their successors have beer elected and have duly qualified.

3. The Chief Councillor shall be elected separately, and then eight Councillors. This Council shall then among themselves elect one of their number as assistant councillor, one as secretary and one as treasurer. The duties of these officers shall be the same as the duties of the officers of similar organizations.

• For the preservation of peace and the enforcement of these bylaws, the Council shall appoint three or more special constables or watchmen, such appointments to become valid when confirmed by the Indian Agent.
