

DATES OF INTEREST

1916.

August 10th ...	First troops embarked for France.
August 25th ...	Took over line from Ypres-Comines Canal to point opposite Messines.
September 23rd	Handed over line and started for the Somme.
September 23rd —October 3rd	Training at Tilques.
October 11th	Took over line in front of Regina Trench.
October 21st	Attack by 10th and 11th Brigades on Regina Trench.
October 25th	Attack by 44th Battalion on Regina Trench.
November 11th	10th Brigade completed capture of Regina Trench.
November 18th	Capture of Desire Trench.
November 28th	Handed over Somme line to 51st Division.
December 4th— December 18th	Refitting in Bruay-Divion area.
December 21st	Took over line on Vimy Ridge, immediately south of Souchez River.

1917.

March 1st ...	Gas attack by 11th and 12th Brigades.
April 9th ...	Attack on Vimy Ridge.
April 11th ...	Capture of "Pimple" by 10th Brigade.
April 13th ...	Line carried out on the flats east of Vimy Ridge.
April 14th ...	Division handed over line to 5th British Division, and moved to Château de la Haie area.
April 25th ...	Took over line between Vimy-Lens Railway and Souchez River.
June 5th ...	Capture of Central Electric Generating Station by 11th Canadian Infantry Brigade.
June 19th ...	Capture of the "Triangle."
June 26th ...	Capture of Brewery and La Coulotte.
June 28th ...	Capture of Eleu dit Leauvette by 12th Canadian Infantry Brigade.
July 2nd ...	Division moved to Barlin area.
July 20th ...	Divisional Sports at Barlin.
July 26th ...	Division took over line astride the Souchez River.
