HERSCHEL'S WEATHER TABLE.

For foretelling the Weather, through all the lunations of the Moon for ever.

Observations.—The nearest the time of the Moon's change, the first quarter, full and the last quarter, are to midnight, the fairer will the weather be during the even days following.

2. The space of this calculation occupies from ten at night till two next morning.

3. The nearer to mid-day or noon the phases of the Moon happen, the more foul r wet weather may be expected during the next seven days.

4. The space of the calculation occupies from ten in the forenoon to two in the flernoon. These observations refer principally to the Summer, though they affect pring and Autumn nearly in the same ratio.

5. The Moon's change, first quarter, full, and last quarter, happening during six s the afternoon hours, i.e., from four to ten, may be followed by fair weather; but his is most dependent on the wind, as is noted in the table.
