- Make return of deaths by contagious disease registered during August., R. S. 5. O., 1897, Chap. 44, section 11 (4).
- Provincial Normal Schools open. 10.
- Last day for county treasurer to return to local clerks amount of arrears due in 15. respect of non-resident lands which have become occupied or built upon.-Assessment Act, section 123, (1.)
 - County selectors of jurors meet .- Jurors Act, section 13.
- Clerk of the Peace to give notice to municipal clerks of number of jurymen 20. required from the municipality.-Jurors Act section 16.

October

- 1. Last day for returning assessment roll to clerks in cities, towns and incorporated villages where assessment is taken between 1st July and 30th September .-Assessment Act, secton 53.
 - Last day for delivery by clerks of municipalities to collectors, of collectors' rolls, unless some other day be prescribed by by-law of the municipality .- Assessment Act, section 95.
 - Notice by trustees of cities, towns, incorporated villages and township boards to Municipal clerk to hold trustee elections on same day as municipal elections, due.—Public Schools Act, sec. 61 (1).

Last day for passing resolution by boards of separate school trustees in urban municipalities that the election of separate school trustees shall be held on the same day as municipal councillors or aldermen are elected, as the case may be.-Separate Schools Act, section 32, sub-section 1. Night schools open (session 1907-1908).
