tion, and which Stalls will answer the purpose intended by an Act passed in the forty leventh year of His Mejesty's Reign, chapter seventh, intituled, " An AE " for building a new Market House in the City of Montreal, for removing part of the . Stalls on the old Market Place, and regulating the fame; and to authorife the bor-" rowing a certain fum of money for those purposes." May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majefly, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Alfembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an A& passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His " Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An AEt for making more effectual provision for the " Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America," and to make further " provision for the Government of the faid Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the passing of this Act, the Act passed in the forty eighth year of his Majesty's Reign, intituled, An AEt to authorife the " Magistrates of the City of Montreal to creft forty temporary Stalls in the new Mar-" ket place, and to borrow a certain fum of Money for that purpofe," fhall be and is hereby repealed; and the forty Stalls erected on the faid new Market Place, for the purpole of felling and expoling to fale all kinds of Butcher's meat, with fuch other Stalls of fimilar conftruction, as by authority of the Magistrates of the City of Montreal may be crefted on the faid new Market Place, shall be taken and confidered as the New Market House, with Stalls, intended by the aforesaid Act of the forty leventh year of His Majelty's Reign, Chapter Seventh; and that henceforth, all the provisions thereof, shall be in force and carried into effect accordingly, except in fo much as relates to the felling of the Butcher's Stalls on the Oid Market Place, which shall be let out by Pub ic Auction or by private Contract at fame time and in fame manner as the Stalls of the New Market Place, and be fubject in all things to the same provisions of the Law.
