foundland, to be Commissioners, they or either of them, jointly or severally, to tender and administer the usual Oath unto the Honorables Edward Morris and Nicholas Stabb, whom we have nominated to be Members of our Legislative Council aforesaid, and also to those Members of the House of Assembly, elected thereto under and by virtue of the provisions of a Proclamation bearing date the twenty-third day of July last past, giving them and either of them, our said Commissioners, full power and authority to perform the matters hereinbefore mentioned, ratifying and confirming ail and whatsoever they or either of them shall do and perform in this behalf, and thereof they or either of them are to make due return under their or either of their hands and seals unto our Governor of our said Island.

Given under the Great Seal of our Island, aforesaid.

Witness our trusty and well-beloved Sir Alexander Bannerman, Knight, our Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over our said Island and its Dependencies, at St. John's, in our said Island, the Twentieth day of January, 1859, and in the Twenty-second year of our Reign.
