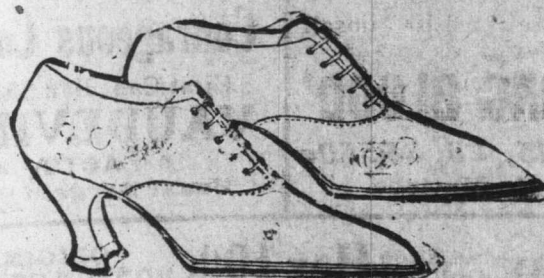

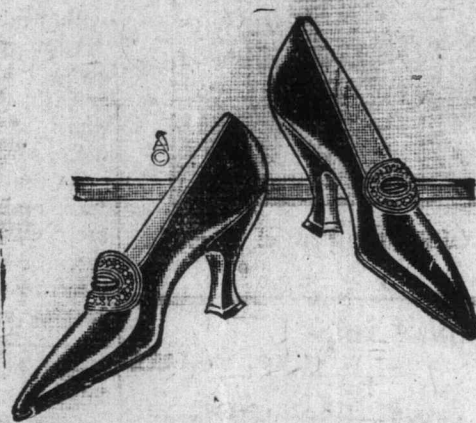

PERMIT FOR
BIG BOUT HAS
BEEN ISSUED

Immense Arena to Be Built at Bay View Park on Maumee Bay

Toledo, O., May 7.—Plans were being drawn today for an immense arena in Bayview Park, on Maumee Bay, in which the Jess Willard-Jack Dempsey 12-round bout for the heavy-weight championship of the world will be staged on July 4th.

Local charities anticipate receiving \$20,000 as a result of the bout, figuring 7 per cent. of the gate receipts, estimated by Frank Flourney, associated with Tex Rickard who promoted the bout, to run about \$300,000. The Toledo Boxing Commission yesterday issued a permit for the bout. The arena in which the fight will be staged at three o'clock on the afternoon of July 4 will seat 50,000 when completed.

OVER \$40,000

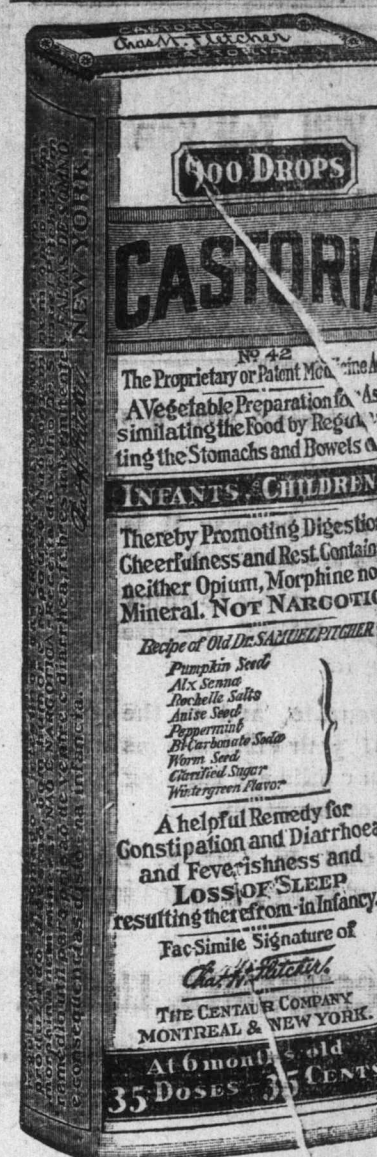
A saving of approximately \$40,000 in the cost of fire-rangings will be effected by Hon. G. Howard Ferguson, Minister of Lands, Forests and Mines as a result of the exceptionally late Spring in the north country.

Owing to the fact that there is still a good deal of snow in the woods, making it practically impossible for fires to get going, there is no need for rangers, and the Department has decided not to send the men into the woods until the 15th. of this month, or about 15 days later than usual. The saving amounts to roughly \$2,700 a day.

At the plenary session of the peace conference Monday Marshal Foch made a speech saying that the security to France is inadequate and that the treaty should not be signed. The Portuguese delegate also expressed dissatisfaction at the treatment of his country and the Chinese repeated their protest. Italy was represented by her ambassador, who had reservations in regard to matters affecting Italy, showing that the settlement of the Fiume dispute has not yet reached a final stage.
