THE DUTY OF CANADIANS.

Now, that the Presidential Election in the United States is over, and the Republicans are masters of the situation, it may not be inopportune to make some observations regarding the relations of the Dominion with that country.

It is, therefore, but foolishness for us to be looking for reciprocity with the United States, when it is quite evident that we are unwilling to grant it. No reasonable man in this country has given an expression of opinion favorable to this question; but, on the contrary, many holders of public opinion have opposed it.

In view of these facts, the mere agitation for reciprocity, without the slightest hope of obtaining it, is not only useless, but injurious, inasmuch as it distracts and divides the public mind. Five millions of people, with the best portion of the North American continent for their inheritance, should not humiliate themselves to the position of supplicants for the crumbs which their neighboring Diva deigns to refuse them.

This Dominion has a broad expanse of rich and generous soil, untold mineral wealth, and unsurpassed fisheries; in fact, everything requisite for the building up of a great nation. The National Policy is conservative of the people's best interests; it fosters native industries and stimulates the development of our vast territories.

A few weeks ago the New York Freeman's Journal had a lengthy article which existed in the Dominion. It went on to show, wherever it got its information, that at least one half the population of Canada were strongly in favor of annexation to the United States.

"We said in a former paper that the Freeman's Journal foretelling ought to be a warning to the Dominion. It is a warning, it is, and it is a warning that we should heed.

"The Freeman's Journal will, we hope, pardon us if we tell it that it really knows absolutely nothing about public affairs in this Dominion.
