The estimates were tabled in the House of Commons, Ottawa on Monday night. They provide for nearly \$18,000,000, on consolidated account, besides some five millions on capital account. In addition to these estimates there will, of course, be supplementaries that will call for several millions more. The amount for railway improvements in this Province is exacted at \$510,950, of which exactly \$500,000, are for the Murray Harbor Branch and the Hillsborough Bridge. Summerdise Breakwater is to get \$35,000; Sausage Breakwater \$20,000 and Casumpey Harbor \$22,000, various other items are down for this Province; but our space is used up. Next week, we will publish the itemized statement. There is no mention of the new Station House at Charlottetown.

The Canada Gazette, of a recent date contains the financial statement of the Dominion Government, for the seven months of the fiscal year ending January, 31st. The statement shows that the revenue for the seven months, amounted to \$32,545,486, almost as much as a full year's revenue, previous to 1896. But while the people have paid all this money into the Federal coffers, the Government have more than kept up the pace in spending. The increase in the revenue, as compared with the same period last year, amounted to \$2,681,187; but the increase in the expenditure is \$3,961,688. It will thus be seen that the statement is worse by over a million and a quarter, notwithstanding the larger amount collected in taxes. The gross debt of the country is about 362 millions of dollars as compared with 352 millions a year ago, and the net debt is 269 millions, against 264 millions this time last year. From this it will be seen that our Grit friends in office at Ottawa, as well as at Charlottetown and everywhere else are powerful at rolling up the debt.

The civic elections, on Wednesday last were warmly contested, more interest being shown in them than for a number of years previously. Mayor Warburton, was reelected; but with an almost tireless new council. Councillors Lyons and Whear, are the only two remaining of the eight who constituted the old board. In addition to these two, councillor Hooper is the only one who has previously been elected, although he did not hold a seat during the last term. The remaining five are all new men in the City Council. The vote was as follows: For Mayor; Warburton, 1304; Kelly, 1109. For Councillors; Ward 1, Lyons, elected by acclamation; Ward 2, Grant, 154, McDonald 136; Ward 3, Clarke, 159, Taylor, 140; Ward 4, Moore, 356, Stewart, 330, Brown, 290; Ward 5, Paton, 762, Hooper, 664, Whear, 608, Reddin, 482, Tanton, 163. The Civic Government, for the next two years, is consequently, constituted as follows: Mayor—Dr. James Warburton. Councillors—Chas. Lyons, Richard Grant, W. W. Clarke, S. C. Moore, Major D. L. Stewart, James Paton, D. L. Hooper, John F. Whear.

WORD comes from Chatham, N. B. that the venerable Bishop Rogers, retires from administrative duties and transfers the government of the diocese of Chatham to his coadjutor and successor, Rt. Rev. Dr. Barry. It will be remembered that about two years ago, Dr. Barry, was consecrated coadjutor to Bishop Rogers, with the right of succession; now he enters upon the full duties of administering his diocese. Bishop Rogers is now 76 years of age and has been Bishop of Chatham, for nearly 42 years. He was consecrated together with the late lamented Bishop McIntyre in the old St. Dunstan's Cathedral, Charlottetown, in 1860. He was but 34 years of age at the time of his consecration and had been only 8 years in the priesthood. He was the first Bishop of Chatham, and there were only 7 priests in the new diocese when he assumed episcopal charge, now there are between 40 and 50 priests in the diocese. He has seen his diocese grow and prosper, and now full of years and labors, he has certainly earned his retirement from the active work of episcopal administration. The address in answer to the speech was taken up in the House of Commons, Ottawa, on Friday, Mr. Campbell of West York was the

mover and Mr. Beland of Beauce was the seconder. Mr. Borden, Leader of the Opposition followed. He received an ovation from the Conservative members and delivered a masterly speech. His pungent remarks regarding the barrenness of the speech and the contradictory speeches delivered, from time to time, by members of the Government rather nettled Sir Wilfrid Laurier, while they won tremendous applause for the speaker. Mr. Borden expressed regret that no reference was made in the speech to the Fast Atlantic Service and that nothing was said about the loss of trade with Germany in consequence of the Government's tariff arrangements. He pointed out the very serious defect in the speech that it contained no information about the Alaska Boundary, and no information concerning the contingent recently sent to South Africa. He made a decided hit, and turned the laughter of the House against the Government when he referred to the numerous and contradictory tariff theories to which different members of the administration had at one time or another given expression. He showed that Mr. Tarte had, on the occasion of a banquet in his honor, declared that the Canadian tariff should be just as protective as that of the United States; that a crisis was at hand; that the United States was endeavoring to make a slaughter market of Canada, and that in consequence of this we should have a tariff that would protect our national industries and waterways that would protect our national trade. In view of such expressions as these and others altogether contrary enunciated by other Cabinet ministers, the Leader of the opposition was at a loss to know which minister voiced the sentiments of the Premier. But he would like to suggest that it might be a good idea for all the ministers except Mr. Tarte, to resign and leave that gentleman to carry out his policy. This was a home thrust and caused much amusement at the Government's expense. Sir Wilfrid's answer was that when the budget would be brought down it would be found that no disagreement existed among the members of the Government. In such a contingency the Minister of Public Works will have to fall into line or leave the Cabinet. The Premier was obliged to confess that the Alaska Boundary Question was in the same position as it was last year. Further than this Sir Wilfrid did not go, thus leaving the House with no more information than what was furnished by the barren speech from the throne.

ceptionally bountiful harvest in Manitoba and the Northwest Territories. It was gratifying to note the cordial reception tendered by all classes of the people to the Prince and Princess of Wales on the occasion of their visit in September and October last, the only respectable feature being the limited time at their disposal, which prevented their visiting many important centres of population. It is, however, a great satisfaction to know that their Royal Highnesses enjoyed their tour through Canada, and carried away the most pleasant recollections of their visit to this part of the Empire. The assassination of President McKinley has elicited a universal feeling of sympathy and sorrow throughout the civilized world, and though Canada has happily not been free from crimes of this character, the close proximity to a United States may make it advisable to join our efforts to the efforts of the United States and other nations, and to provide by legislation for the adequate punishment of those who, either by speech or writing, incite fanatics to the perpetration of such horrible crimes. Gentlemen of the Senate: Gentlemen of the House of Commons: In meeting you again at the commencement of another session of parliament, it is my first duty to express the deep sense of our gratitude to Divine Providence for the many blessings which Canada has received during the

In South Africa.

One hundred and fifty Mounted Infantry while patrolling Klip River, south of Johannesburg, on February 12th, founded a farm house where they suspected Boers were hiding.
