GERMAN SPY RELEASED.

NEW YORK, Nov. 29. Pardoned by President Coolidge and freed from a life sentence at Leavenworth Penitentiary, Lothar Witzke, the only German spy convicted h the United States during the war, 'sas deported to-day on the Hambuig liner Alberton. He was convicted of Espionage and sentenced to death, but the sentence was commuted to life in prison.
